


INTRODUCTORY NOTE

The following bibliography is prepared for those of us whose aim in dealing with the foreign-born is "not to coerce but to liberate." It is intended, as its name implies, for social workers rather than for students and, consequently presupposes that such workers, for the most part, have neither the time nor the training for prolonged and exhaustive research. The titles selected, therefore, are those of books that are easily accessible as well as of those most likely to prove helpful toward an enlightened and sympathetic understanding of the problems and aims of the foreign-born residents of the United States. With this object in view many books and articles have been included which are thoroughly partisan in their treatment and tone because they present points of view with which the social worker must be prepared to cope.

Any suggestions tending to make this bibliography more helpful in fulfilling its purpose will be most heartily welcome.
